6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to foreign trade zones; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 45 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 77. FOREIGN TRADE ZONES.

11 Sec. 45.77.010. APPLICATION FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF FOREIGN TRADE
12 ZONE. The commissioner of commerce and economic development may apply
13 to the United States Department of Commerce to establish, operate, and
14 maintain foreign trade zones as provided in the Foreign Trade Zones Act
15 (19 U.S.C. 81a - 19 U.S.C. 81u).

16 * Sec. 2. AS 29.13 is amended by adding a new section to read:

17 Sec. 29.13.200. POWERS AUTHORIZED TO HOME RULE MUNICIPALITIES. A
18 home rule municipality may apply to the United States Department of
19 Commerce to establish, operate, and maintain a foreign trade zone as
20 provided in the Foreign Trade Zones Act (19 U.S.C. 81a - 19 U.S.C. 81u).

21 * Sec. 3. AS 29.53.020(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

22 (7) property located within a foreign trade zone established
23 by the state under AS 45.77.010 or by the municipality under AS 29.13.-
24 200, except the property may be taxed under this chapter after the
25 property is cleared by the United States Customs Service and admitted
26 into domestic commerce.

27 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1980.
