6 For an Act entitled: "An Act continuing the existence of the Board of Elec-
7 trical Examiners and amending the laws relating to the
8 licensing of electrical administrators and to electrical
9 safety."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 08.03.010(c) is amended by adding a new paragraph to
12 read:

13 (2) Board of Electrical Examiners (AS 08.40.010) -- June 30,
14 1984.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 08.40.010 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 08.40.010. CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD. There is [HERE-
17 BY] created a Board of Electrical Examiners consisting of three members
18 who are licensed electrical administrators and two members of the public
19 who are not licensed electrical administrators.

20 * Sec. 3. AS 08.40.135(b) is amended to read:

21 (b) A lapsed license may be reinstated without examination by
22 payment of all unpaid renewal fees and a penalty fee of \$25 for each
23 year the license has been lapsed unless the license has been lapsed for
24 more than two [THREE] years. If a person's license has been lapsed for
25 more than two years, he is required to take an examination under AS 08.-
26 40.120 [AND THE BOARD HAS REASON TO BELIEVE THAT IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO
27 REQUIRE THE LICENSEE TO TAKE AND PASS THE EXAMINATION GIVEN UNDER AS 08.-
28 40.120].

29 * Sec. 4. AS 08.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

1 Sec. 08.40.145. LICENSE BY ENDORSEMENT. The board shall adopt
2 regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act
3 (AS 44.62) for the issuance of a license to a person who is licensed as
4 an electrical administrator in a state other than Alaska.

5 * Sec. 5. AS 08.40.150 is amended to read:

6 Sec. 08.40.150. FEES. (a) Each applicant shall pay an original
7 license fee of \$150 [\$100].

8 (b) The fee for biennial renewal of a license is \$150 [\$100].

9 * Sec. 6. AS 18.60.580 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 18.60.580. MINIMUM ELECTRICAL STANDARDS. The latest [1978]
11 published edition of the National Electrical Code approved by the
12 American Standards Association, and the latest published edition of the
13 National Electrical Safety Code issued by the United States Department
14 of Commerce, Bureau of Standards, constitute the minimum electrical
15 safety standards of the state.

16 * Sec. 7. AS 18.62.010 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 18.62.010. CERTIFICATE OF FITNESS REQUIRED. In connection
18 with work performed subject to the standards established in [AS 18.60.-
19 580 AND] AS 18.60.705, a [NO] person may not be employed without a
20 certificate of fitness to perform the work.

21 * Sec. 8. AS 08.03.010(b)(5) is repealed.
