6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the State Commission for Human
7 Rights."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 18.80 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 18.80.115. CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION. Except as provided in
11 AS 18.80.105, the commission may not make public the name of a person
12 alleged to have committed an act or practice declared unlawful in this
13 chapter during an investigation conducted by the commission under AS 18.
14 80.110. The records of investigation and information obtained by the
15 commission during an investigation under AS 18.80.110 are confidential
16 and may not be made available by the commission for inspection by the
17 general public. However, the commission is not prevented from issuing
18 public statements describing or warning of a course of conduct which
19 constitutes or will constitute an unlawful act or practice under this
20 chapter, and the commission is not prohibited from making information
21 public to the extent necessary to perform its duties or exercise its
22 powers under AS 18.80.105 and 18.80.120 - 18.80.145.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 18.80.300 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

24 (11) "commission" means the State Commission for Human Rights;

25 (12) "executive director" means the executive director of the

26 State Commission for Human Rights.
