5 Directing the Legislative Council to
6 study and hold hearings on the avail-
7 ability of automobile insurance in
8 the state.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the legislature has been told that Alaskans have encountered
11 difficulties in obtaining and paying for insurance for the operation of their
12 automobiles; and

13 WHEREAS several companies which have been doing business in Alaska have
14 withdrawn from the Alaska market, and insurance costs have continued to rise,
15 and companies remaining in the market have become more selective in their
16 agreements to write policies; and

17 WHEREAS many Alaskans feel that they are unable to obtain the necessary
18 coverage at prices they can afford; and

19 WHEREAS the impact of a decision not to insure on individuals left
20 without protection in the event of substantial physical injury or property
21 damage is extremely serious;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Legislative
23 Council is requested to appoint an interim committee and to assign to it the
24 responsibility of investigating the conditions existing in the Alaska auto-
25 mobile insurance market and determining whether serious problems exist for
26 Alaskans seeking to acquire or maintain automobile insurance; and be it

27 FURTHER RESOLVED that this interim committee is requested to report its
28 findings and recommendations, including possible corrective legislation, to
29 the legislature not later than the convening of the Eleventh Legislature -
