5 Relating to the dedication of land to  
6 the Wood-Tikchik State Park.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS under AS 41.20.470(b) a described parcel of land, 126,720 acres  
9 in extent and immediately adjacent to the Wood-Tikchik State Park, can be  
10 added to the park upon proclamation of the governor; and

11 WHEREAS various uses of this land are now being made or contemplated  
12 which make necessary the immediate closing of this land to multiple purpose  
13 use and the dedication of it as a special purpose site to protect the area's  
14 fish and wildlife habitat and breeding areas and to preserve the continued  
15 use of the area for subsistence and recreation; and

16 WHEREAS the provisions of AS 41.20.480 and 41.20.490 providing for local  
17 participation in management decisions would be extended to this land were it  
18 included in the Wood-Tikchik State Park;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests  
20 the Governor proclaim the land described in AS 41.20.460(b) part of the  
21 Wood-Tikchik State Park.
