Relating to gasoline pumps.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the costs of all grades of motor fuel are rapidly increasing due

to world events; and

9

WHEREAS should the price of fuel surpass \$1 a gallon, as is expected,

10

modifications must be made to gas pumps to enable them to calculate the total

11

owed at such rates; and

12

WHEREAS specifications and tolerances for gas pumps appearing in National

13

Bureau of Standards Handbook 44 and supplements to it have been adopted by

14

reference by the terms of AS 45.75.050(d), and these specifications may

15

prohibit the completion of the necessary modifications; and

16

WHEREAS AS 45.75.050(d) provides that these specifications and toler-

17

ances can be modified, amended, or rejected by regulations issued by the

18

director of weights and measures;

19

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it respectfully

20

requests the Governor to direct the director of weights and measures to adopt

21

the necessary regulations.
