3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 ELEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the continuation of the
6 satellite television project.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission operates the tele-
9 vision demonstration project on behalf of the state; and

10 WHEREAS the television demonstration project began as a demonstration
11 project, but has successfully proven that it provides a critical service to
12 42 communities in Alaska, and methods to continue it as an ongoing program
13 should be explored; and

14 WHEREAS the Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission has been assisting the
15 Department of the Air Force by providing them with limited access to the
16 state-funded satellite project;

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Alaska Public
18 Broadcasting Commission, on behalf of the state, enter into negotiations with
19 the Air Force to provide satellite television service similar to that being
20 provided to other residents of the state; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of the Governor is requested to approve
22 any agreement to provide this service that is reached between the Alaska
23 Public Broadcasting Commission and the Department of the Air Force.
