4 ELEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Endorsing an action of the Alaska  
6 Coastal Policy Council.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS AS 46.40 establishes the Alaska coastal management program, and  
9 the general obligation of local governments to undertake coastal resource  
10 planning, and AS 44.19.891 establishes the Alaska Coastal Policy Council; and

11 WHEREAS the Annette Island Indian Reserve, while legally not a coastal  
12 resource district under the terms of Alaska law and not part of Alaska's  
13 coastal zone under the terms of federal law, has nevertheless engaged in a  
14 cooperative coastal planning effort with the Alaska coastal management pro-  
15 gram; and

16 WHEREAS, in a grant agreement between the Annette Island Indian Reserve  
17 and the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, the Annette Island  
18 Indian Reserve received funding with which to develop a coastal program and  
19 agreed to produce a coastal program that would be consistent with the Alaska  
20 coastal management program and the guidelines and standards of the Alaska  
21 Coastal Policy Council; and

22 WHEREAS the Annette Island Indian Reserve completed and approved such a  
23 program and submitted it to the Alaska Coastal Policy Council for review and  
24 approval; and

25 WHEREAS the Alaska Coastal Policy Council conducted a regular review of  
26 the Annette Island Indian Reserve coastal program and approved the program;  
27 and

28 WHEREAS the Alaska Coastal Policy Council has requested the legislature  
29 to endorse the council's approval of the Annette Island Indian Reserve

1 coastal management program to acknowledge this achievement;

2 BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with the findings and conclusions of  
3 the Alaska Coastal Policy Council the Alaska State Legislature endorses the  
4 coastal management program of the Annette Island Indian Reserve, and offers  
5 appreciation for a job well done.
