BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the fourteenth annual Boys' State will be held June 6 - 13,

1980, at Camp Carroll (Fort Richardson) under the sponsorship of the American

Legion and cooperating organizations; and

WHEREAS this fine annual program of the Legion ranks high among the

efforts of several Alaskan organizations to bring to the youth delegates an

13

awareness of their future roles in state and local government; and

WHEREAS this week-long youth citizen exercise of Boys' State at Camp

15

Carroll and its companion activity of Girls' State at Sitka are made possible

by an admirable combination of volunteer service and the free enterprise of

generous people and organizations without dependence on government or any

18

burden on the taxpayer; and

WHEREAS it is consistent with these standards for the legislature to

encourage state and local legislators and other public officials and agencies

to volunteer their services and provide copies of state publications and

22

materials related to the program;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature salutes the sponsors of

and participants in the fourteenth annual Boys' State program; commends to
