5 Relating to use of alternative energy  
6 sources for oil and gas facilities.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS facilities for preparing, transporting and conditioning oil and  
9 gas presently use petroleum products for energy required in these processes;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS the energy demand placed on the resource for this use is very  
12 substantial; and

13 WHEREAS alternative energy sources are available and if alternative  
14 sources were used they would have a significant conservation effect on a  
15 resource in critical supply throughout the world; and

16 WHEREAS, in today's world, consideration of the use of an alternative  
17 energy source to replace energy derived from petroleum products, when real  
18 possibilities for this replacement exist, is vital;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that under AS 24.20.090  
20 and Uniform Rule 48(c) the legislative council is directed to provide for a  
21 study, through the Joint Interim Committee on Gas Pipeline Financing, of the  
22 possibility of the use of alternative energy sources to replace energy  
23 derived from petroleum products for purposes of preparing, transporting and  
24 conditioning oil and gas; and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Joint Interim Committee on Gas Pipeline  
26 Financing, acting as a subcommittee of the legislative council, is directed  
27 to report to the legislature through the legislative council its finding and  
28 recommendations by the 30th day of the First Session of the Twelfth Legis-  
29 lature.
