Requesting the governor to direct the

stocking of Anchorage lakes and

streams.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS the people of Anchorage make great use of the lakes and streams

12 in the Anchorage area for fishing purposes; and

13 WHEREAS the demand for lakes and streams which are plentifully stocked

14 with fish outweighs the current availability; and

15 WHEREAS this demand causes most of the lakes and streams in the

16 Anchorage area to be fished out every season; and

17 WHEREAS fish cannot survive through the winter in many of the lakes; and

18 WHEREAS there is no spawning in the lakes; and

19 WHEREAS the Department of Fish and Game is required to restock the lakes

20 and streams each spring; and

21 WHEREAS the hatcheries are not able to provide enough fish to stock the

22 lakes and streams to the extent necessary to meet public demand; and

23 WHEREAS the Department of Fish and Game states that they need more breed

24 stock to adequately stock the lakes and streams;

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the governor is

26 respectfully requested to direct the Department of Fish and Game to conduct a

27 study regarding the feasibility of increasing the breed stock of hatcheries

28 in order to increase the amount of fish available for restocking Anchorage

29 lakes and streams on a seasonal basis; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Fish and Game report the
2 findings of its study to the Twelfth Legislature no later than January 30,
3 1981.
