2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 21

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 ELEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the Consti-
6 tution of the State of Alaska relat-
7 ing to state aid to private educa-
8 tional institutions.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Article VII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
11 amended to read:

12 SECTION 1. PUBLIC EDUCATION. The legislature shall by general law
13 establish and maintain a system of public schools open to all children
14 of the State, and may provide for other public educational institutions.
15 Schools and institutions so established shall be free from sectarian
16 control. [NO MONEY SHALL BE PAID FROM PUBLIC FUNDS FOR THE DIRECT
17 BENEFIT OF ANY RELIGIOUS OR OTHER PRIVATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION.]

18 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
19 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity
20 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election
21 laws of the state.
