BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Congress of the United States is considering the enactment

of H.R. 6073; and

WHEREAS H.R. 6073 is proposed legislation which directs the President to

12

take certain actions with respect to a country which engages in certain

13

hostile actions against property of the United States or United States offi-

14

cers or employees assigned to duty abroad; and

15

WHEREAS the crises in Iran and Columbia illustrate the need to develop

16

effective diplomatic and economic sanctions to discourage hostile actions

17

against officers, employees and property of the United States;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully encourages

19

Congress to pass H.R. 6073 and fully supports the enactment of legislation

20

directed at preserving the safety and integrity of officers and employees of

21

the United States serving abroad and protecting United States property lo-

22

cated in foreign countries.
