8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 The Alaska State Senate congratulates John Butrovich, the "Dean of the  
10 Alaska Senate," on his selection as Alaskan of the Year, 1980:

11 John Butrovich: You have dedicated your life to the service of the  
12 people of this state. Your ability, dignity and dedication to Alaska  
13 characterize all that is best in public service.

14 For 30 years you served as a member of the Senate of the Territorial and  
15 State Legislatures, a record of tenure that almost surely will not be  
16 matched. You were a member of every committee of the Senate, and were chosen  
17 by your colleagues as President of the Fifth State Senate. On the occasion  
18 of your 1978 retirement from active legislative service, you won the praise  
19 of the press and public, and achieved the unique distinction of being  
20 designated an honorary member of the House of Representatives.

21 By deed, not word, you worked your influence. Interest in your  
22 Fairbanks friends and neighbors was your lifelong concern, and you were  
23 diligent in their behalf. When quiet action was not enough, you chose to  
24 speak, as when, as a senior spokesman in your party, you issued your timely  
25 appeal to President Eisenhower urging his support of statehood.

26 Your integrity and long service have earned you the respect and love of  
27 your constituents and fellow senators. Now we and they join with all  
28 Alaskans in recognition of your many contributions and your richly deserved  
29 award as Alaskan of the Year.
