2 Under the authority of art. III, sec. 23, of the Alaska Constitution,
3 and in accordance with AS 24.30.130(b), I order the following:

4 * Section 1. FINDINGS. As governor, I find that it would be in the best
5 interests of efficient administration to transfer the statutory responsi-
6 bility for inspecting certain recreational devices from the Department of
7 Public Safety to the Department of Labor.


8 * Sec. 2. AS 05.20.020 is amended to read:
