6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to motor vehicle registration; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.10.101 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 28.10.101. EXPIRATION OF REGISTRATION. Unless otherwise
11 specified, each vehicle registration issued under this chapter expires
12 on the transfer or assignment of title or interest in the vehicle.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.411(a) is amended to read:

14 (a) A [FOR EVERY YEAR DURING ANY PART OF WHICH A] vehicle is
15 subject to registration under this chapter, and a registration fee
16 shall be paid to the department at the time of original acquisition and
17 each time title or interest in the vehicle is transferred or assigned
18 [REGISTRATION AND AT EACH ANNUAL RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION AFTER THAT
19 TIME].

20 * Sec. 3. AS 28.10.421(b) is amended to read:

21 (b) The [ANNUAL] registration fees under this subsection are
22 imposed within the following classifications for:

23 (1) a passenger vehicle or motor home not used or maintained
24 for the transportation of persons or property for hire or for other
25 commercial use \$30;

26 (2) a pick-up truck or a van not exceeding 6,000 pounds
27 unladen weight and not used or maintained for the transportation of
28 persons or property for hire or for other commercial use \$35;

29 (3) a taxicab \$65;

1 (4) a motor bus with a seating capacity for 20 or more per-
2 sons and used exclusively for commercial purposes in the transporting
3 of visitors or tourists

4 \$80;

5 (5) a motorcycle or a motor-driven cycle \$15;

6 (6) a two- or four-wheeled trailer not used or maintained
7 for the transportation of persons or property for hire or for other
8 commercial use, including, but not limited to, a boat trailer, baggage
9 trailer, box trailer, utility trailer or house trailer \$ 5.

10 * Sec. 4. AS 28.10.421(c) is amended to read:

11 (c) The [ANNUAL] registration fees under this subsection are
12 imposed and are based upon the actual unladen weight as established by
13 the manufacturer's advertised weight or upon the actual weight which
14 the owner shall furnish, subject to the approval of the commissioner or
15 his representative, for a vehicle, including a motor vehicle pulling a
16 trailer or semi-trailer, used or maintained for the transportation of
17 passengers for hire, excepting taxicabs and buses under (b) of this
18 section, or for the transportation of property for hire or for other
19 commercial use, including a commercial vehicle such as a trailer,
20 semi-trailer, truck, wrecker, tow car, hearse, ambulance, and tractor,
21 as follows:

22 (1) up to and including 5,000 pounds \$ 45;

23 (2) more than 5,000 pounds to and including 12,000
24 pounds \$ 80;

25 (3) more than 12,000 pounds to and including 18,000
26 pounds \$150;

27 (4) more than 18,000 pounds \$215.

29 (d) The special registration fees under this subsection are im-

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posed [ANNUALLY, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED,] for:

(1) an historic vehicle [(ONE TIME ONLY UPON INITIAL REGISTRATION UNDER AS 28.10.181)] \$10;

(2) special request plates \$20;
plus the fee required for that vehicle under (b)(1) or (2) of this section; the fee required by this paragraph shall be collected only on the first issuance and on the replacement of special request plates;

(3) a vehicle owned by a disabled veteran or other handicapped person, and registered under AS 28.10.181 or a resident 65 years of age or older who complies with AS 28.10.411(c) none;

(4) a vehicle owned by the state none;

(5) a vehicle owned by an elected state official the fee required for that vehicle under (b) of this section;

(6) a vehicle owned by a consular officer, unless waived under AS 28.10.181 \$30;

(7) a vehicle owned by a rancher, farmer, or dairyman and registered under AS 28.10.181 \$30;

(8) a snowmobile or off-highway vehicle \$ 5;

(9) an amateur mobile radio station vehicle,
(A) with a transceiver capable of less than 5-band operation the fee required for that vehicle under (b) or (c) of this section;

(B) in recognition of his service to the public: a mobile amateur radio station owned by an amateur with general class or higher license, provided the station must be satisfactorily proved capable of operating on at least five bands between 160 through 10 meters, must have an antenna, and must have a power supply and wiring as a permanent part of the vehicle; the transmitting unit may be removed from the car for service or dry

2 vehicle included in (b)(1) or (2) of this section;

3 (10) dealer registration plates,

4 (A) the initial set of plates \$40;

5 (B) each subsequent set of plates \$20;

6 (11) a vehicle owned by a municipality or charitable organi-
7 zation meeting the requirements of AS 28.10.181(e) \$ 5;

8 (12) an occasional use vehicle under AS 28.10.181(k).. \$15.

9 * Sec. 6. AS 28.10.105, 28.10.107, 28.10.111, 28.10.411(d), 28.10.421(a),
10 and 28.10.431 are repealed.

11 * Sec. 7. This Act takes effect January 1, 1982.
