7 entering premises licensed to serve alcoholic bever-

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 04.16.030 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 04.16.030. SALE OR DISPOSITION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO
12 DRUNKEN PERSONS. A licensee, his agent, or employee may not knowingly,
13 recklessly, or with criminal negligence

14 (1) sell, give, or barter alcoholic beverages to a drunken
15 person;

16 (2) allow another person to sell, give, or barter an alco-
17 holic beverage to a drunken person within a licensed premises;

18 (3) allow a drunken person [TO ENTER AND REMAIN WITHIN
19 LICENSED PREMISES OR] to consume an alcoholic beverage within a li-
20 censed premises;

21 (4) permit a drunken person to sell or serve alcoholic
22 beverages.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 11.81.350(c) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

24 (3) nondeadly force upon another person when and to the
25 extent he believes it necessary to terminate what he reasonably believes
26 to be the commission of a violation of the prohibition against a drunken
27 person entering premises licensed to serve alcoholic beverages (AS 04.-
28 16.040).
