6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to officers and terms of members of
7 the Legislative Council; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 24.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 24.20.025. OFFICERS. The council shall have a chairman and
12 vice-chairman and may have other officers as determined by the council.
13 The chairman and vice-chairman may not be from the same house. If the
14 terms of the members appointed by one house expire under the provisions
15 of AS 24.20.030(a) and the chairman of the council is from that house,
16 the vice-chairman shall become chairman, and the appointing authority
17 of the other house shall designate a vice-chairman from the members of
18 the council appointed from that house.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 24.20.030(a) is amended to read:

20 (a) Members serve for the duration of the legislature during
21 which they are appointed and, if they are reelected to or their term of
22 office extends into the next succeeding legislature, continue to serve
23 until reappointed or their successors are appointed, except the terms
24 of all members appointed by a president of the senate or a speaker of
25 the house expire if the president or speaker who made the appointments
26 ceases to hold office during the legislature in which the appointment
27 was made. The resulting vacancies shall be filled by appointment by
28 the successor president or speaker.

29 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
