5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting charging of tuition at community
7 colleges."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. The legislature intends that attendance
10 at community colleges be feasible for adults, low income students, and
11 persons needing remedial education and finds that elimination of tuition
12 would encourage attendance by these groups of people.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 14.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

14 Sec. 14.40.605. TUITION PROHIBITED. A student attending a commu-
15 nity college may not be charged tuition, fees, or any other charge
16 designed to cover the cost of operations of the community college.

17 * Sec. 3. AS 14.40.610 is repealed.
