6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the charging of tuition at commu-
7 nity colleges."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.40.605. TUITION PROHIBITED. (a) A student attending a
11 community college may not be charged tuition.

12 (b) In this section, "tuition" means payment made by a student in
13 exchange for instruction, but does not include fees assessed to recover
14 the cost of books, lab equipment, shop materials, or other instructional
15 materials.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 14.40.610 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 14.40.610. DISPOSITION OF INCOME. (a) All money, includ-
18 ing [TUITION AND] fees received before or after April 10, 1962, from
19 the operations of a community college established, operated, and main-
20 tained under AS 14.40.560 - 14.40.640 and directly related or attri-
21 butable to academic degree programs and activities, shall be placed in
22 the community college fund of the University of Alaska.

23 (b) All money, including [TUITION AND] fees received before or
24 after April 10, 1962, from the operations of a community college estab-
25 lished, operated and maintained under AS 14.40.560 - 14.40.640 and
26 directly related or attributable to nondegree programs and activities
27 of the community college, shall be placed in the appropriate fund of
28 the qualified school district or political subdivision cooperating with
29 the university in the establishment of the community college.
