6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing mandatory imprisonment and fines
7 as penalties for violation of hunting laws prohibiting
8 waste of moose and caribou."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.30.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

11 (e) If a person is convicted under this section of failing to
12 salvage edible moose or caribou meat, the court shall impose a minimum
13 sentence of imprisonment of five days and a minimum fine of \$2,500.
14 The execution of the minimum sentence under this subsection may not be
15 suspended nor may probation be granted until the minimum imprisonment
16 provided in this section has been served. Imposition of sentence may
17 not be suspended.
