6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to regulation and licensing of  
7 veterinarians."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.98.050(9) is amended to read:

10 (9) collect, or cause to be collected, data concerning the  
11 practice of veterinary technology [MEDICINE] by veterinary technicians  
12 in the state and submit the data to the department for maintenance;

13 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.98.180 is amended to read:

14 Sec. 08.98.180. TEMPORARY LICENSE. A person who meets the  
15 requirements of AS 08.98.165(a)(1) and (5) is entitled to be tempo-  
16 rarily licensed after applying for examination, if the person works  
17 under the supervision of a licensed veterinarian [COMPLETING THE EXAM-  
18 INATIONS UNDER AS 08.98.165(a)(3) AND (4) AND AFTER COMPLETING THE  
19 EXAMINATION REQUIRED UNDER AS 08.98.165(a)(2) OR QUALIFYING FOR AN  
20 EXEMPTION TO IT]. A license issued under this section is valid until  
21 the results of the examinations are published. No person may receive  
22 more than one temporary license. An application for a temporary  
23 license must be signed by the supervising veterinarian and accompanied  
24 by the temporary license fee as prescribed under AS 08.98.190.
