6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to bison."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.05.430(a) is amended to read:

9 Sec. 16.05.430. PENALTIES. (a) A person who violates AS 16.05.-
10 330 or 16.05.420 is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is
11 punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for
12 not more than six months, or by both except that a person who violates
13 AS 16.05.330 by taking a bison without a license or nonresident big
14 game tag is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.900(a) is amended to read:

16 (a) A person who violates AS 16.05.870 - 16.05.895 or 16.05.920
17 or any regulation adopted [PROMULGATED] under this chapter is guilty of
18 a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of not more
19 than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by
20 both, except that if the game which is the subject of the violation is
21 bison, a person who violates AS 16.05.920 or any regulation adopted
22 under this chapter is guilty of a class A misdemeanor. A person who
23 violates a regulation adopted [PROMULGATED] under this chapter for the
24 regulation of commercial fisheries shall be punished as provided in
25 AS 16.05.720.
