6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to revocation or limitation of the
7 driver's license of a person under 19 years of age who
8 is convicted of driving while intoxicated."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.15.181(b) is amended to read:

11 (b) Except as provided in (c) of this section, a [A] court convict-
12 ing a person of an offense under (a)(1) - (7) of this section shall
13 revoke that person's driver's license for a period of not less than 30
14 days for the first conviction, unless the court determines that the
15 person's ability to earn a livelihood would be severely impaired and a
16 limitation under sec. 201 of this chapter can be placed on the license
17 which will enable the person to earn a livelihood without excessive risk
18 or danger to the public. If a court limits a person's license under
19 this subsection, it shall do so for a period of not less than 30 days.
20 Upon a subsequent conviction of a person for any offense under (a) of
21 this section, the court shall revoke the person's license and may not
22 grant him any limited license privileges for the following periods:

23 (1) not less than one year for the second conviction; and
24 (2) not less than three years for a third or subsequent
25 conviction.

26 * Sec. 2. AS 28.15.181 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

27 (c) A court convicting a person under 19 years of age of driving
28 while intoxicated under AS 28.35.030 shall revoke the person's driver's
29 license for a period extending until the person reaches the age of 19 or

1 for a longer period, unless the court limits the person's license in
2 accordance with AS 28.15.201. If a court limits a person's license
3 under this subsection, it shall do so for a period extending until the
4 person reaches the age of 19 or for a longer period.
