5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing the Chukchi Community College;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. CHUKCHI COMMUNITY COLLEGE ESTABLISHED. The Chukchi Commu-  
10 nity College is established as part of the Northwest Arctic School District.  
11 Costs of operating the Chukchi Community College may be paid from appropria-  
12 tions for the purpose, from tuition and fees received from the operation of  
13 the community college, or from other sources, but money received by the  
14 Northwest Arctic School District under AS 14.17 may not be used for the  
15 Chukchi Community College.

16 \* Sec. 2. ACCREDITATION. The Northwest Arctic School District shall  
17 seek accreditation of the Chukchi Community College by the Northwest Accred-  
18 iting Association.

19 \* Sec. 3. REPORTS. Within 30 days after the beginning of each legis-  
20 lative session, the Northwest Arctic School District shall submit a report  
21 on the operations of the Chukchi Community College to the legislature. The  
22 report shall include

23 (1) a description of expenditures and sources of revenue for the  
24 community college during the preceding academic year;

25 (2) the number of full-time and part-time students enrolled each  
26 semester in each location offering community college courses during the pre-  
27 ceding academic year;

28 (3) the number of student credit hours completed during the  
29 preceding academic year in each discipline for which community college

1 courses were offered, at each grade level, and at each location offering the  
2 courses;

3 (4) the number of student non-credit hours completed during the  
4 preceding academic year at each location offering community college courses;

5 (5) the number of adult basic education student credit and  
6 student non-credit hours completed during the preceding academic year at  
7 each location offering community college courses;

8 (6) the number of full-time and part-time faculty members teach-  
9 ing community college courses during the preceding academic year in each  
10 discipline for which courses were offered;

11 (7) an inventory of educational materials used by the community  
12 college;

13 (8) a description of buildings and facilities used by the commu-  
14 nity college;

15 (9) a description of services offered to students by the community  
16 college;

17 (10) a description of new programs planned for the community  
18 college;

19 (11) the student attrition rate from the community college during  
20 the preceding academic year;

21 (12) a projection of the amount of money needed for operating  
22 expenses of the community college during the next academic year, a projec-  
23 tion of sources of revenue, and a request for an appropriation to be used  
24 for operating expenses not paid for by other sources of revenue.

25 \* Sec. 4. The existence of Chukchi Community College is terminated and  
26 secs. 1 - 3 of this Act are repealed July 1, 1986.

27 \* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1981.
