6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the amounts for state grants to
7 agricultural and industrial fairs; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 03.20.020(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) Fairs may be held each year in each of the house election
12 districts, and state aid for the operation and maintenance of the fairs
13 may not exceed a basic grant of \$500,000 [\$10,000]; however, fairs in
14 existence five years or longer may receive an increment grant not to
15 exceed \$250,000 [\$2,500] per year of existence to a maximum of
16 \$1,000,000 [\$75,000]. The people of each district sponsoring a fair
17 are not eligible for state aid unless they subscribe to spend from
18 their own funds for that purpose an amount equal to the amount of the
19 state aid and have or organize an agricultural and industrial fair
20 association for the operation and maintenance of the fairs. Each fair
21 receiving state aid is open to entries by the people of the whole state
22 and special provision shall be made for exhibits from boys' and girls'
23 clubs.

24 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
25 070(c).
