6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to transfer or reassignment of  
7 teachers."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.148 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (b) A teacher may not be involuntarily transferred or reassigned  
11 within a city or borough school district or within a regional educa-  
12 tional attendance area except for reasonable cause. Reasonable cause  
13 for an involuntary transfer or reassignment may be established only  
14 through procedures negotiated under AS 14.20.550. The procedures shall  
15 provide that the final step is binding arbitration. The procedures  
16 shall also provide a method of selecting the arbitrator. For the  
17 purposes of this section, "reasonable cause" does not include union  
18 activity, political activity, or disciplinary action.
