6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the crime of intimidation."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.41 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 ARTICLE 5. INTIMIDATION.

10 Sec. 11.41.480. INTIMIDATION. A person commits the crime of
11 intimidation if, because of another person's race, color, religion,
12 ancestry, or national origin,

13 (1) he intentionally causes physical harm to the other
14 person;

15 (2) by word or conduct he intentionally places or intention-
16 ally attempts to place the other person in fear of imminent physical
17 harm; or

18 (3) he intentionally interferes with, damages, or destroys
19 the property of the other person.

20 (b) Intimidation is a class C felony.
