* Section 1. AS 16.05.835 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.835. MAXIMUM LENGTH OF SALMON SEINE VESSELS. No salmon

seine vessel may be longer than [50 FEET, OFFICIAL COAST GUARD REGISTER

LENGTH, AND] 58 feet overall length except

13

(1) vessels that have taken [FISHED FOR] salmon with seines

14

in waters of the state before January 1, 1962, as 50-foot, official

15

Coast Guard register length vessels; and

16

(2) vessels that take salmon with seines in Southeastern

17

waters of the state east of the longitude of Cape Fairweather.
