6 For an Act entitled: "An Act directing the commissioner of administration  
7 to implement an energy conservation program for certain  
8 procurement activities of the state; and providing for  
9 an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 44.21.020 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

12 (13) adopt regulations to implement the energy conservation  
13 procurement policy set out in AS 46.11.070.

14 \* Sec. 2. AS 46.11 is amended by adding a new section to read:

15 Sec. 46.11.070. ENERGY CONSERVATION PROCUREMENT POLICY REGULA-  
16 TIONS. (a) By July 1, 1982, the commissioner of administration shall  
17 adopt regulations to implement a procurement policy applicable to state  
18 agencies. The regulations adopted shall be reasonably necessary to  
19 promote energy conservation in the acquisition and use of equipment,  
20 materials, and supplies, and shall include, but are not limited to,

21 (1) procedures to determine life cycle costs of equipment,  
22 based on acquisition costs, the cost of operating the equipment during  
23 its anticipated useful life, maintenance costs of equipment during its  
24 anticipated useful life, and the anticipated resale or salvage value of  
25 the equipment;

26 (2) minimum standards of energy efficiency of equipment,  
27 based on applicable federal energy efficiency standards and average  
28 fleet fuel economy for automobiles; and

29 (3) limits on the acquisition of equipment, materials, and

1 supplies until the state agency proposing to acquire the materials and  
2 supplies has considered the availability of recycled equipment,  
3 materials, and supplies.

4 (b) The regulations adopted by the commissioner of administration  
5 shall include bid procedures applicable to the acquisition of equip-  
6 ment, materials and supplies by state agencies by which the state  
7 agency may evaluate compliance of a bid with the provisions of (a) of  
8 this section before making a bid award.

9 (c) The commissioner of administration may not adopt regulations  
10 under this section until the director of the Alaska Energy Center  
11 (AS 46.12) and the director of the division of energy and power develop-  
12 ment in the Department of Commerce and Economic Development are allowed  
13 to review and comment on the regulations.

14 (d) The commissioner of administration may assist state agencies  
15 in complying with regulations adopted under this section.

16 (e) By the 10th day of each regular session of the legislature,  
17 the commissioner of administration shall submit a report to the legis-  
18 lature on the regulations adopted under this section, and on compliance  
19 with the regulations by state agencies. The report shall contain

20 (1) the actual energy costs and the energy conserved as a  
21 result of compliance by state agencies with the regulations adopted  
22 under this section; and

23 (2) the estimated energy costs and estimated energy which  
24 may be conserved as a result of compliance by state agencies with the  
25 regulations adopted under this section.

(A) if the bid involves energy-consuming equipment, the life cycle costs and energy efficiency standards of the equipment;

(B) if the bid involves materials and supplies, the proposed use of recycled products in the materials and supplies when the use of recycled products is economical;

(2) condition acceptance of a bid submitted under this section on compliance by the bidder with bid regulations adopted under AS 46.11.070.
