6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the establishment of uniform  
7 notice requirements; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. FINDINGS. The legislature finds that natural resource.  
11 development in the state may be unnecessarily hindered by inconsistent  
12 notice requirements for state permits. To eliminate such inconsistencies,  
13 the governor should have the authority to reconcile conflicting statutory  
14 requirements.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 44.62 is amended by adding a new section to read:

16 ARTICLE 8A. ISSUANCE OF PERMITS.

17 Sec. 44.62.632. UNIFORM NOTICE REQUIREMENTS. If the governor  
18 finds that the statutory notice requirements for different department-  
19 ally required permits for a specific activity or undertaking are incon-  
20 sistent, the governor may establish uniform statutory notice require-  
21 ments. In making the determinations required under this section, the  
22 governor shall consult with the principal executive officers of the  
23 departments requiring permits for the specific activity or undertaking.  
24 The notice requirement prescribed by the governor may not

25 (1) allow less than a 30-day notice period before the  
26 proposed action;

27 (2) eliminate the requirement that the notice be published  
28 in a newspaper of general circulation or trade or industrial publica-  
29 tion; or

1 (3) eliminate the requirement that a person who has requested  
2 notice of a proposed action receive notice.

3 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-  
4 070(c).
