6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the employment, nonretention, or  
7 dismissal of teachers; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.130 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

11 (b) Before a contract is issued to a teacher who has not been  
12 employed in the district during the school year preceding the year for  
13 which the contract is to be issued, the employer shall submit the  
14 contract to the parent-teacher organization for the location where the  
15 teacher is to be employed. The parent-teacher organization may approve  
16 or disapprove the contract within 30 days after the contract is received  
17 for review. If the parent-teacher organization disapproves the contract  
18 within the prescribed time limit, the contract may not be issued by the  
19 employer. If the parent-teacher organization approves the contract, or  
20 fails to take action within the prescribed time limit, or if there is  
21 no parent-teacher organization for the location where the teacher is to  
22 be employed, the contract may be issued by the employer.

23 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.20.180 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

24 (d) Before a dismissal or nonretention decision becomes final  
25 under this section the employer shall submit the proposed dismissal or  
26 nonretention decision to the parent-teacher organization for the loca-  
27 tion of the teacher's employment. The parent-teacher organization may  
28 approve or disapprove the proposed dismissal or nonretention decision  
29 within 30 days after the decision is referred for review. If the

parent-teacher organization disapproves the dismissal or nonretention within the prescribed time limit, the teacher shall be retained by the employer. If the parent-teacher organization approves the dismissal or nonretention decision, or fails to take action within the prescribed time limit, or if there is no parent-teacher organization for the location of the teacher's employment, the employer's dismissal or nonretention is effective.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1981.
