6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the employment and dismissal of
7 teachers; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.20.130 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (b) Before a contract is issued to a teacher who has not been
11 employed in the district during the school year preceding the year for
12 which the contract is to be issued, the employer shall submit the
13 contract to the parent-teacher organization for the location where the
14 teacher is to be employed. The parent-teacher organization may approve
15 or disapprove the contract within 30 days after the contract is received
16 for review. If the parent-teacher organization disapproves the contract
17 within the prescribed time limit, the contract may not be issued by the
18 employer. If the parent-teacher organization approves the contract, or
19 fails to take action within the prescribed time limit, or if there is
20 no parent-teacher organization for the location where the teacher is to
21 be employed, the contract may be issued by the employer.

22 * Sec. 2. AS 14.20.170 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

23 (c) A school board shall dismiss a teacher if the parent-teacher
24 organization for the location of the teacher's employment files a
25 request for the dismissal with the school board containing a statement
26 of the reasons for dismissal and the school board determines that the
27 statement establishes cause for dismissal under (a) of this section.

28 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1981.
