6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the powers and duties of the
7 telecommunications divisions; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 44.21.220(6) is amended to read:

11 (6) whenever feasible, procure services from private enter-
12 prise or certified and franchised utilities and contract for the con-
13 struction, management, operation, and maintenance of telecommunications
14 systems, and develop a procurement policy under AS 37.05; the procure-
15 ment policy must seek to achieve the maximum benefit to the public, and
16 methods of procurement, including lease, purchase, rental, or combina-
17 tions of lease, purchase, and rental, must be selected on the basis of
18 factors such as the ratio of long-range costs versus benefits and [,]
19 life cycle costing [, AND THE COSTS TO THE COMMUNICATIONS INDUSTRY TO
20 THE EXTENT THAT THESE COSTS MAY AFFECT LOCAL AND LONG DISTANCE BASIC
21 TELEPHONE RATES];

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1981.
