6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations to the Department
7 of Transportation and Public Facilities for preliminary
8 engineering and design projects and for right-of-way
9 acquisitions; and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The sum of \$3,345,000 is appropriated from the general fund
12 to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for preliminary
13 engineering and design projects to be allocated as follows:

14	Minnesota extension phase II	\$ 500,000
15	New Seward Highway -- Dimond to Tudor (six-lane)	200,000
16	Lake Otis Parkway -- Tudor to Abbott (four-lane)	100,000
17	Lake Otis Parkway -- Abbott to Huffman extension	150,000
18	Jewel Lake Road -- Raspberry to Dimond	180,000
19	Dimond Boulevard -- Jewel Lake to Sand Lake	100,000
20	Minnesota and International Airport Road interchange	200,000
21	Minnesota and Raspberry interchange	300,000
22	Bragaw -- Abbott to O'Malley extension	150,000
23	Bragaw -- Abbott to Tudor extension	165,000
24	Seward and 36th	200,000
25	Whittier access	1,100,000

26 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$6,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
27 the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for right-of-way
28 acquisitions as follows:
