6 For an Act entitled: "An Act repealing the Alaska coastal management pro-
7 gram; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. The following laws are repealed: AS 44.19.155 - 44.19.162;
10 AS 44.47.095; AS 46.40.010 - 46.40.210; and secs. 1 and 2, ch. 84, SLA 1977.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 38.05.037(b) is amended to read:

12 (b) The division of lands may exercise its zoning power
13 [(1)] within federal lands in the unorganized borough only at
14 the times and in the areas it is requested to do so by the Secretary of
15 the Interior to facilitate sales of federal lands within the unorganized
16 borough under P.L. 88-608, 78 Stat. 988 [;

17 (2) WITHIN ANY PORTION OF A THIRD CLASS BOROUGH COVERED BY
18 THE ALASKA COASTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAM ADOPTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
19 PROVISIONS OF AS 46.35 IF THE MUNICIPALITY HAS NOT DONE SO].

20 * Sec. 3. AS 41.17.020(j) is amended to read:

21 (j) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the
22 commissioner may not employ the authority vested by this chapter so as
23 to duplicate or preempt the statutory authority of other state agencies
24 to adopt regulations or undertake other administrative actions governing
25 resources, values, or activities on forest land except, [FOR (1) REGULA-
26 TIONS UNDER THE COASTAL MANAGEMENT ACT; AND (2)] if authorized by the
27 commissioner of environmental conservation, regulations relating to
28 control of nonpoint source pollution.

29 * Sec. 4. AS 41.17.040(b) is amended to read:



(b) The board is composed of 13 [14] members appointed by the governor from nominations submitted from the groups listed in (c) of this section. The board shall elect its own presiding officer.

* Sec. 5. AS 41.17.010(6) and 41.17.040(c)(7) are repealed.

* Sec. 6. This Act takes effect July 1, 1981.
