6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state capital projects; and pro-
7 viding for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 37.07.020(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) In addition to the budget and general appropriation bill, the
11 governor shall annually submit

12 (1) a capital improvements program including, but not limited
13 to, projects that may be completed during the succeeding six fiscal
14 years that the governor has directed be designed and engineered by the
15 Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, but that have not
16 received appropriations for construction; and

17 (2) a financial plan covering the succeeding six fiscal
18 years.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 37.07.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

20 (e) The capital improvements program submitted under (b)(1) of
21 this section shall include proposed projects that have not yet received
22 an appropriation for construction and a request for an appropriation
23 sufficient for preliminary investigation of each project. The estimated
24 construction cost of the proposed projects for which no appropriation has
25 been made and the estimated construction cost of those projects for which
26 an appropriation has been made shall not be less than \$1,000,000,000.

27 * Sec. 3. AS 44.42 is amended by adding a new section to read:

28 Sec. 44.42.090. DESIGN AND ENGINEERING OF CAPITAL PROJECTS. The
29 department shall annually submit a report to the governor describing

those capital projects that are proposed to be designed and engineered but have not received an appropriation for construction. The estimated construction cost of the proposed projects for which no appropriation has been made and the estimated construction cost of those projects for which an appropriation has been made shall not be less than \$1,000,000,000. The department shall include for each project the costs required for design and engineering the project to the state at which bids for the project can be solicited. The department shall maintain a file of projects that have been designed and engineered but have not received an appropriation for construction.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1982.
