6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing an advisory vote on raising the age
7 of majority to 21 for the purpose of regulation of
8 alcoholic beverages and authorizing an advisory vote on
9 legalizing possession of marijuana by adults for their
10 own use; and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. The lieutenant governor shall place before the qualified
13 voters of the state at the next general election a question advisory to the
14 legislature of whether the legislature should enact laws that would raise the
15 age of majority from 19 to 21 years for the purpose of regulation of the
16 sale, consumption, service, furnishing, barter, purchase, gift, or delivery
17 of alcoholic beverages. The question shall appear on the ballot in the
18 following form:

27 ture of whether the legislature should enact laws that legalize possession of
28 marijuana by adults for their own use. The question shall appear on the
