

7 state government; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. Included within the general fund amounts appropriated accord-  
10 ing to the schedules in sec. 10 of this Act, the following amounts are from  
11 the unreserved special accounts in the general fund:

	Operating	Capital
12 Highway Fuel Tax Account	18,500,000	
14 Aviation Fuel Tax Account	4,500,000	

15 \* Sec. 2. A sum is appropriated from the general fund necessary to pay  
16 interest on revenue anticipation notes issued by the commissioner of revenue  
17 under AS 43.08.010.

18 \* Sec. 3. If federal or other program receipts exceed the estimates  
19 appropriated by this Act, the appropriation from state funds for the affected  
20 program may be reduced by the amount of the excess if the reductions are not  
21 inconsistent with applicable federal statutes.

22 \* Sec. 4. If program receipts fall short of the estimates appropriated by  
23 this Act, the affected appropriation shall be reduced by the amount of the  
24 shortfall in receipts.

25 \* Sec. 5. If the federal receipts under Title XX of the Social Security  
26 Act (42 U.S.C. 1397 et. seq.) fall short of the estimate, the amount of the  
27 shortfall is appropriated from the general fund.

28 \* Sec. 6. Amounts equivalent to the amounts to be received in settlement  
29 of insurance claims for property losses are appropriated from the general

This is a general amendment to the Finance Committee Substitute and will affect the central office or Commissioner's office of each state agency. The changes are numerous and will be accomplished during the enrolling and engrossing process.

The numbers of full-time and part-time positions authorized by the House budget as shown in parentheses on the line items are reduced by 5%. The 5% reduction in authorized positions, when allocated to each state agency, leaves the amended budget authorized positions as shown on the following table. Each Commissioner or agency head shall allocate the reduction of positions within the agency:
