BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 28.15.125. DISTINGUISHING LICENSE FOR DRIVER CONVICTED OF DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED. (a) The department shall issue a distinctive and readily identifiable distinguishing driver's license or a duplicate driver's license to an otherwise qualified applicant convicted under AS 28.35.030 of driving while intoxicated. A distinguishing license shall be issued under this section upon conviction and for six months after the expiration of the period of revocation or limitation of the applicant's driver's license imposed under AS 28.15.181(b) as a result of the conviction.

(b) A person who receives a distinguishing license under (a) of this section may, if otherwise qualified, apply for and receive a standard driver's license or a standard duplicate driver's license six months after the period of revocation or limitation of the applicant's driver's license imposed as a result of the conviction for driving while intoxicated.
