6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the term of office for members and
7 to the powers of the Board of Regents of the University
8 of Alaska."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.40.140 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 14.40.140. TERM OF OFFICE. Except for a student regent as
12 specified in AS 14.40.150(b), the term of office of a regent is five
13 [EIGHT] years. The term of office begins on the first Monday in
14 February of the year in which the appointment is made. Each regent
15 serves until his successor is appointed and qualifies. A regent who has
16 served for two full successive terms is not eligible to again be a regent
17 until one full term has intervened. The regents serve staggered terms.

18 * Sec. 2. A member of the Board of Regents of the University of Alaska
19 appointed before the effective date of this Act may serve for the remainder
20 of the eight-year term for which appointed. The term for the first and
21 second regents appointed or reappointed after the effective date of this Act
22 is two years. The term for the third and fourth regents appointed or re-
23 appointed after the effective date of this Act is three years. The term for
24 the fifth and sixth regents appointed or reappointed after the effective date
25 of this Act is four years. The term for all other regents appointed or
26 reappointed after the effective date of this Act is five years.

27 * Sec. 3. AS 14.40.170(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:
28 (7) not allow a special break for tuition fees and other fees
29 or allow a waiver for tuition fees and other fees for university
