6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the effect of absences from the  
7 state on receipt of the Alaska Longevity Bonus; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 47.45.030 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 47.45.030. ABSENCE FROM THE STATE. A recipient shall notify  
12 the commissioner of administration when he expects to be absent from the  
13 state if the absence is for a continuous period that exceeds 90 [30]  
14 days. After that notification, the recipient shall no longer receive  
15 bonuses from the Department of Administration after his last regularly  
16 approved monthly application. Upon his return to the state he may again  
17 make application for a bonus. Whenever the absence is for a continuous  
18 period that exceeds 180 days the recipient shall be disqualified from  
19 receiving bonuses for the next 12 calendar months after his return to  
20 the state. However, when the commissioner of administration determines  
21 a period of absence is beyond the control of the recipient, he may not  
22 be disqualified, if he still otherwise qualifies upon his return to the  
23 state. Continual absences from the state, even though reported, and  
24 failure to notify the commissioner of an expected absence may be grounds  
25 for disqualification.
