6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring that advertising by a contractor  
7 include the contractor's state registration number."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.18.051 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.18.051. REGISTERED NAME. Except as provided otherwise by  
11 state law, no person who has registered under one name as required by  
12 this chapter may act in the capacity of a contractor under any other  
13 name unless that name also is registered. All advertising, contracts,  
14 correspondence, cards, signs, posters, papers and documents prepared by  
15 a contractor which show his name and address shall show his name and  
16 address as registered under this chapter and all advertising shall in-  
17 clude his registration number as required by AS 08.18.111. Individual  
18 contractors and partners, associates, agents, salesmen, solicitors,  
19 officers and employees of contractors shall use their true names and  
20 addresses at all times while acting in the capacity of a contractor or  
21 performing related activities.

22 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.18.111 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 08.18.111. ADVERTISING [BOND AND INSURANCE]. (a) A [NO]  
24 contractor may not advertise that he is bonded and insured simply be-  
25 cause he has complied with the bond and insurance requirements of this  
26 chapter.

27 (b) A contractor may not advertise his services by publication,  
28 dissemination, solicitation, endorsement, circulation, or any other  
29 means unless he displays or states his registration number.

2 (d) If a contractor fails to comply with the requirements of  
3 AS 08.18.111(b) or if a licensed contractor fails to fulfill his obliga-  
4 tions as set out in AS 08.18.071, his license shall be suspended for a  
5 period of time the commissioner determines is appropriate. After three  
6 suspensions his license may be permanently revoked.
