6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing a reserve account for personal
7 leave, annual leave, and sick leave for state employ-
8 ees; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 37.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 37.05.156. RESERVE FOR PERSONAL LEAVE, ANNUAL LEAVE, AND SICK
12 LEAVE. (a) There is established in the general fund a reserve account
13 for personal leave, annual leave, and sick leave for state employees.
14 The account consists of money appropriated to it, and amounts charged to
15 agency appropriations, at a rate determined by the Department of Adminis-
16 tration, as leave is earned by state employees.

17 (b) The cost of leave used must be charged against the reserve
18 account as leave is used by state employees.

19 (c) The commissioner of administration shall conduct an annual
20 review of the reserve account and shall advise the director of budget
21 and management by January 15 of each year of the following:

22 (1) the results of operations of the reserve account during
23 the previous fiscal year including the status of any appropriations made
24 to the account;

25 (2) the balance of the account compared with the calculated
26 liability for personal leave, annual leave, and sick leave for state
27 employees at the end of the previous fiscal year;

28 (3) any appropriations needed because of negotiated salary in-
29 creases or because of other events that have resulted in significant

change in the liability of the state for leave for state employees;

(4) the recommended rate at which agency appropriations should be charged for leave earned by state employees during the next fiscal year.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1983.
