6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to publications of executive agencies."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 44.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 44.65.070. RESTRICTIONS ON PUBLICATION OF REPORTS AND PUBLICA-
10 TIONS. (a) A department or agency that proposes to spend state money
11 appropriated by the legislature for publications that contain the use of
12 more than one color of ink shall specifically identify under AS 37.07.-
13 050(a)(3) the amount of its budget necessary for those publications.
14 The recommendation of the governor under AS 37.07.060(a) shall identify
15 the amount of the budget of a state department or agency necessary for
16 the publications containing the use of more than one color of ink.

17 (b) State money appropriated by the legislature may not be spent
18 for the publication of a report to the governor or the legislature if
19 more than a minimum number of copies are printed or if the report is
20 printed with the use of more than one color of ink.

21 (c) State money appropriated by the legislature may be spent for
22 publications that are not a report to the governor and legislature and
23 that use more than one color of ink only if the use of more than one
24 color of ink is approved by the governor and the head of the department
25 or agency issuing the publications. The governor and the head of the
26 department or agency may not delegate the authority to approve use of
27 more than one color of ink in publications under this section.
