6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to vendors' fees for the issuance of
7 sport fishing and hunting licenses and tags; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05.390 is repealed and reenacted to read:

11 Sec. 16.05.390. VENDORS' FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF LICENSES AND TAGS. A
12 person who is not a salaried employee of the state who is appointed by
13 the commissioner of revenue to sell licenses and tags is entitled to
14 retain 10 percent of the fee charged for each license or tag sold, or 50
15 cents, whichever is greater. If the fee for the license or tag is less
16 than 50 cents, the person selling the license or tag may retain the
17 entire fee. Each person selling licenses or tags shall, as soon as
18 practicable after the last day of each calendar month, transmit the
19 proceeds from the sales, except the amount authorized to be retained,
20 together with a report of the sales to the commissioner for deposit in
21 the fish and game fund or the general fund. Fees imposed under AS 16.-
22 05.340(e) shall be transmitted in the same manner.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
24 070(c).
