5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the installation of fiberglass  
7 ducts in buildings."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 18.60 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 12. FIBERGLASS DUCTS.

11 Sec. 18.60.825. FIBERGLASS DUCTS PROHIBITED. It is unlawful for a  
12 supplier, contractor, or installer, other than a private homeowner  
13 installing ducts in an owner-occupied single dwelling, to knowingly  
14 install, have installed, or consent to the installation of ducts, a duct  
15 system or interior sound lining constructed of fiberglass, fibrous glass  
16 or spun glass in a building.

17 Sec. 18.60.830. EMPLOYEES NOT COVERED. No liability under AS 18.-  
18 60.825 - 18.60.845 is created as to workmen who are employees of a  
19 material supplier, contractor, subcontractor or other employer respons-  
20 ible for compliance with AS 18.60.825 - 18.60.845.

21 Sec. 18.60.835. PENALTY. A person who violates AS 18.60.825 -  
22 18.60.845 is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable  
23 by a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment  
24 for not more than one year, or by both.

25 Sec. 18.60.840. LOCAL ORDINANCES. Except when a city or borough  
26 ordinance is more strict or broader in its application, AS 18.60.825 -  
27 18.60.845 supersede a city or borough ordinance relating to fiberglass  
28 ducts.

29 Sec. 18.60.845. APPLICABILITY. AS 18.60.825 - 18.60.845 apply

1 only to duct or duct system installations made after January 1, 1983,  
2 but do not apply to contracts awarded, under an invitation for bids,  
3 before January 1, 1983.
