6 Boys' State at Camp Carroll.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the fifteenth annual Boys' State will be held June 5 - 12,
9 1981, at Camp Carroll (Fort Richardson) under the sponsorship of the American
10 Legion and cooperating organizations; and

11 WHEREAS this fine annual program of the Legion ranks high among the
12 efforts of several Alaskan organizations to bring to the youth delegates an
13 awareness of their future roles in state and local government; and

14 WHEREAS this week-long youth citizen exercise of Boys' State at Camp
15 Carroll is made possible by an admirable combination of volunteer service
16 and the free enterprise of generous people and organizations without depend-
17 ence on government or any burden on the taxpayer; and

18 WHEREAS it is consistent with these standards for the legislature to
19 encourage state and local legislators and other public officials and agencies
20 to volunteer their services and provide copies of state publications and
21 materials related to the program;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature salutes the sponsors
23 of and participants in the fifteenth annual Boys' State program; commends to
24 the attention of government officials and agencies and private individuals
25 and organizations the opportunity to support and participate in this exercise
26 in youth citizenship; and pledges to continue to provide legislative mater-
27 ials, advice and encouragement to the Boys' State program as it does to
28 similar worthy civic efforts.
