2 CS FOR HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 30 (Transportation)
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 TWELFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the addition of clover
6 seed to grass seed as a ground cover
7 along highways and airports.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS a ground cover along Alaska highways and airports should be
10 attractive and practical; and

11 WHEREAS clover has a luxuriant green appearance; and

12 WHEREAS, since clover is a lower growing plant than grass and does not
13 need to be mowed as frequently, the state would reduce maintenance expenses
14 by using clover rather than grass as a ground cover; and

15 WHEREAS the use of clover as a ground cover along highways and airports
16 would increase the potential for Alaska honey production since clover is an
17 important source of pollen and nectar for bees;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
19 respectfully requested to direct the Department of Transportation and Public
20 Facilities to add clover seed to grass seed when planting ground cover along
21 highways and airports in areas where the use of clover would not be detrimen-
22 tal to the appearance or maintenance of the ground cover.
