5 Requesting the governor to grant a
6 pardon to Daniel Boone Reed.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Daniel Boone Reed, having been convicted of arson in 1941 and
9 having served eight years in federal jail, had his civil rights revoked; and

10 WHEREAS Daniel Boone Reed has been an exemplary, law-abiding citizen
11 since his release from jail more than 30 years ago; and

12 WHEREAS Daniel Boone Reed, now in his seventies and a longtime resident
13 of Kodiak Island, is a leader among its senior citizens and well respected
14 throughout the community;

15 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
16 the governor to grant Daniel Boone Reed a full pardon and restore his civil
17 rights.

19 Governor of Alaska; and to Terry Miller, Wilson Condon, and Charles Adams,
20 members of the Clemency Review Committee.
